## Our LEARNINGS

**2025** marked a year of **consolidation** and **sharper focus...**

Our grant-making continued to centre on women facing immediate hardship, particularly survivors of violence and abuse, while also strengthening our investment in projects delivering longer-term empowerment and system change. We saw increasing demand for trauma-informed, community-based support, alongside growing impact from preventative and skills-focused work.

In response, AWWF refined its funding approach to balance urgent need with sustainable outcomes, ensuring our grants deliver both depth and reach. We also continued our diversification into areas such as: business support & STEM, homelessness, perinatal support, mental health and the Arts. We hope to continue this diversification in coming years to expand our reach ever further to positively impact even more women's lives in ever more varied ways.

## Our IMPACT

**2025** was a year of **significant reach** and **meaningful outcomes.**

AWWF supported over **29,000** women and girls, funding frontline services, peer support, education, creative recovery and survivor-led initiatives across the UK. Behind every number is a woman or girl whose safety, confidence or opportunity has been strengthened.
